While looking for new permits to show Films at their Spanish Film Club, RAÍCES, had the fortune to meet JJ. Montero from Con Un Pack Distribución in Madrid, and their acquaintance resulted in the idea of making an event where independent films from Spain could be shown in Aarhus.

The idea soon grew to the desire that Aarhus should have its own film festival. The world premier of *Keep Away From Fire* will be a

feature of the festival. The director and producer of the film, Javier Artigas, was an ERASMUS student in Aarhus.

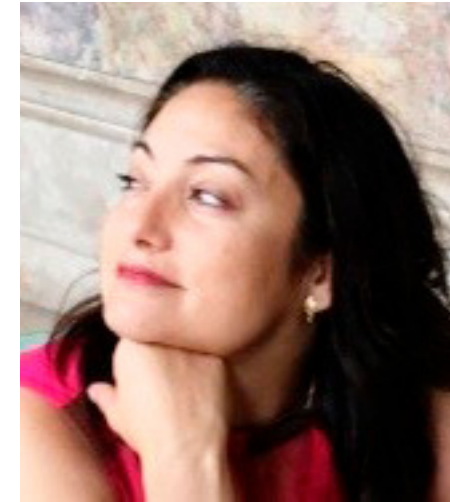
This year three of the films are from Spain while Latin-America is represented by *Pasaje de Vida*, which is an Argentinian-Spanish production.

The ¡BRAVO! Spanish and Latin-American Independent Film Festival is an initiative made possible by the Aarhus' Spanish

Speaking community, which made it theirs from the start.

The name of the festival ¡BRAVO!, a suggestion from Miguel San Román, was chosen by the public, from a list of ten different options.

It was Susana Mellerup of the Department of Spanish at Aarhus University and the endorsement of the Center for Latinamerica (LACUA), which made it possible to



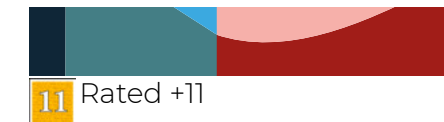
have a place to hold the event, without which we would not have a festival.

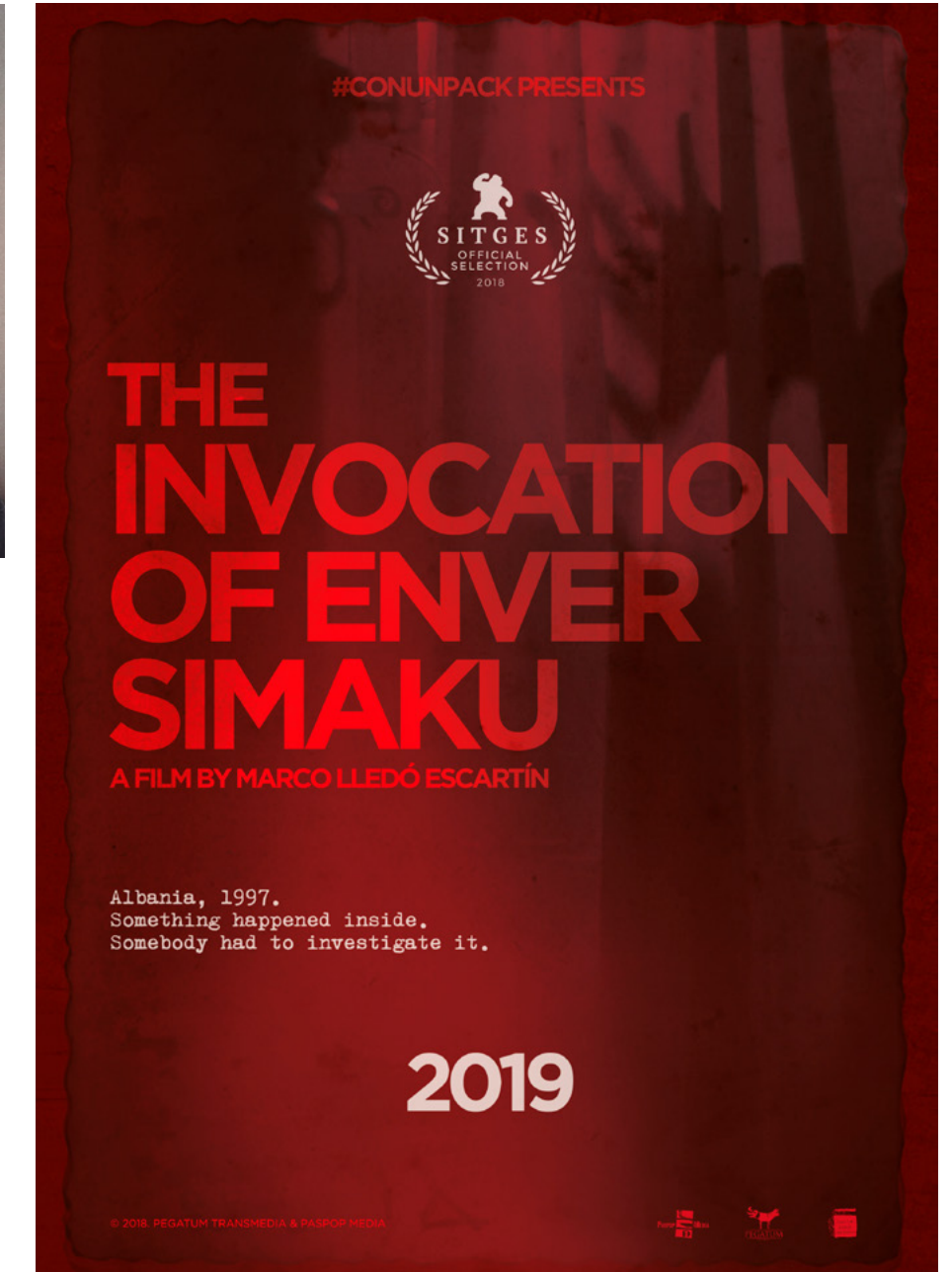
